Please refer to your fitting instruction to ensure that the roof racks are installed in the



Check the contents of kit before commencing fitment and report any discrepancies





From the top of the vehicle, fold open each plastic flap and remove the grub screws from the bottom of the cavities with the Allen key provided. Remove any excess body filler from the bottom of the cavities. Screw the brass mounting studs into the threaded holes, and tighten lightly with a flat-bladed screw driver.





Care Instruction:


Wash and clean vehicle roof prior to fitting the Rhino Sportz roof racks.

Tools Required

Allen key, provided in kit

Phillips head & flat bladed screwdrives

Install each pad into each cavity, ensuring that the plastic flap is folded right up and the curved portion of the pad's top recess is towards the outside of the vehicle.




Insert the support leg fully into the cross bars. A rubber mallet may be required to knock the leg into place.

Insert the rubber buffer strip into the top of each cross bar.

Place the cross bars onto the pads. Note that the cross bar lengths are different front, centre and rear. Refer to layout drawing for correct positioning.

Assemble the spring washers and the flat washers onto the security screws, slipping the spring washer on first. Insert the screws into the support leg mounting holes and screw down into the brass mounting studs under the pads, using the security Allen key provided. NOTE The shorter **35mm screws** go into the **centre** pads and the longer **50mm screws** go into the **front and rear pads**. Do not over-tighten .

Recommendations

It is essential that all bolt connections be checked after driving a short distance when you first install your crossbars. Bolt connections should be checked again at regular intervals (probably once a week is enough, depending on road conditions, usage, loads and distances travelled). You should also check the roof bars each time they are refitted.

Make sure to fasten your load securely. Please ensure that all loads are evenly distributed and that the centre of gravity is kept as low as possible.

Use only non-stretch fastening ropes or straps.

Sensitivity to Crosswinds, Behaviour in Curves and Braking

The handling characteristics of the vehicle, changes when you transport a load on the roof. For safety reasons, we recommend you exercise extreme care when transporting wind-resisting loads; special consideration must be taken into account when braking.

Please remove crossbars when putting vehicle through an automatic car wash.

Load Ratings

Maximum permissible total load is 100kg for the 3 bars (include the weight of the roof bars, 8kg). When roof racks are to be used in off-road conditions, please build a safety factor of 1.5 into this load limit. Although the roof racks are tested and approved to AS1235-2000, Australian road conditions can be much more rigorous. However, increasing the number of crossbars does not increase the vehicles maximum permissible roof loading.
